# Annual Show Participant Waiver



## Making Your Show Safer

By acquiring a ticket for (visitor, guest) or agreeing to attend (volunteer, service provider, food vendor, ground space stallholder) the Toodyay Agricultural Show, you agree to the general Participation Conditions below.

*“Participant”* means visitor, guest, volunteer (including community group members), service provider (including entertainers), food vendor and / or ground space stallholder.

*“Society”* means Toodyay Agricultural Society (Inc).

By entering the event all the Participant acknowledges that they have read, understood and agree to the **Participation Conditions**.

## Participation Conditions

All Participants agree to follow the relevant WA Government required physical distancing and hygiene measures to reduce the chance of spreading the COVID-19 and confirm that they are complying with current border restrictions, self-isolation and testing requirements.

Service providers (including entertainers), food vendors and ground space stallholders are responsible for the provision of the hygiene items required to undertake their task/s, including in relation to interaction with the public.

For example, a poster should be displayed promoting requirements at the location along with the provision of hand sanitiser and / or antibacterial wipes.

The Society will make payment to service providers (including entertainers) upon presentation of an invoice on, or following, event day.

If the service provider’s terms require payment of a non-refundable deposit, up to 10% of the expected total cost will be paid upon presentation of an invoice at least 28 days before the event.

In the event of a WA Lockdown the Participant indemnifies the Society against all loss, damages, claims, liability, expenses, payments or outgoings that they might incur, arising directly or indirectly from the cancellation of the Show.

The Society will refund paid ticketholders, food vendors and ground space stallholders in full.

In the event of a Regional Lockdown all service providers (including entertainers), food vendors and ground space stallholders from outside the Toodyay / Wheatbelt region agree to apply for a G2G pass ([www.g2gpass.com.au/](http://www.g2gpass.com.au/)) to assure their attendance (if the pass is approved).

If the WA Government declare a limit to numbers in attendance at public events, the Society reserves the right to amend, or cancel, participant services with no penalty.
