Once again, here is our bit of motivation for all those green fingers out there who want to plant vegetables in time for the Toodyay Show but were unsure of the right planting times.

Below are some planting times that I acquired from our retired-to-Mandurah-local, champion vegie grower, retired Steward and now Judge, Mr Len Leeder ten years ago. Hopefully this will get some new entrants to boost the Fruit & Vegetable Section. So here we go, for the week starting...

- May 20th plant Potatoes;
- June 3rd plant Broad Beans;
- June 10th plant Rhubarb & Silverbeet;
- July 1st plant Cabbages, Cauliflowers, Beetroot, Peas & Broccoli;
- July 8th plant Turnips, Swedes & Snow Peas;
- July 22nd plant your Lettuces.

Hopefully this information on planting will encourage those young, and not so young, Show entrants to plant something new and try something different; even those who have never entered vegetables before, GIVE IT A GO!

It's such a big year for the Toodyay Ag Society that if you were not in the know already, the Show Dance to celebrate the 170th Show is in organisation mode.
