One thing that every community in a country town needs, be it large or small, is an event that brings together individuals and businesses alike to participate, support and engage with each other. One of those special events, our historic 170th Anniversary Toodyay Agricultural Show occurred recently on Saturday 5th October, making the Committee believe that all the effort put in had been worthwhile; proved by the smiling faces, outstanding crowd numbers of over 5,000 through the gate and the constant activity in the halls and on the Showground. Put your hand up if you agree!!

We are very proud of our history as since the Society's establishment in 1853, the iconic Toodyay Agricultural Show has played a key role in our community, and we always attempt to celebrate this.

A sight to remember this year was our WA Governor, His Excellency the Hon Chris Dawson AC APM and Mrs Dawson, arriving in a vintage Stutz car with the TAS President Ms Karen Dore to the Showgrounds, guided by three well known locals riding vintage motorbikes. Life Member Mrs Kerry Knowles was the MC and proceeded to introduce the Welcome to Country, the WA Governor's Opening of the Toodyay Show as well as the presentation of the handcrafted Quilt for the special year, to the President, by representatives of the local Quilting Groups who had produced the showstopper.

Even as the Governor viewed the Showgrounds after the Opening and Morning Tea with Life Members; the Show proceeded, and the crowd increased. The full Show Train arrived bringing many eager Show visitors to Toodyay and we are hoping to lock in place TransWA for another train next year. Overall, the Equestrian Pleasure Show had pony rings that were filled with activity nearly all day. 78 Trade exhibits/market stalls made the ground space along with Sideshow Alley a magnet for the families. Popularity awards must go to the poultry stewards and exhibitors, goats of ANY breed, Butterflies 'n' Mini Beasts, Heritage Chillies, Lucas Timber Mill and the WA Police Display. With 26 entertainment groups, the Committee made sure that all interests were covered. How fantastic were the Exhibition Halls this year packed with over 1,630 entries from the community and surrounding regions, with the school displays covering the walls, adding to the overall colour of the Floriculture & Craft sections.

The Livestock did not disappoint with all the Cattle Yards full, a packed Poultry Shed guarded by Henrietta the Hay Hen; the Sheep Pavilion was filled with a variety of breeds in competition, sharing the space with the WA Dairy Goats. Wool and Agriculture were both well supported which was in itself great to see from the local farmers. Our 170th Anniversary Toodyay Agricultural Show did not disappoint anybody on a day that was just blessed by exceptional weather.

The Committee work so hard during the year to organise this Show that endeavours to cater for every single age group, personality and interest. With the positive and complimentary comments received on the day and after, the Committee members believe that we achieved this. We are looking at better promotion of "entering the Show" next year, entries made easier, especially with the online entries. Social media and our website promotion was excellent this year, motivating everybody to enter that rose, jar of relish, or dare I say the Man Cake!
