Each year, the Society invites community support to help bring the Toodyay Agricultural Show to life.

## About the Toodyay Agricultural Society

The Toodyay Agricultural Society, founded in 1853, is the second oldest of its kind in Western Australia and is the oldest continuously operating community group in Toodyay.

Coordinated by an eighteen-member volunteer committee, the Society organises the annual Toodyay Agricultural Show, bringing the community together and bridging the city-country gap.

Whist the focus remains on local agriculture, over many decades the Show has evolved into a more diverse community centred event. Exhibitors display crafts, needlework, art, produce, cooking, flowers and more. Highlights include kids' displays, trade exhibits, equestrian events, market stalls, sideshow alley, free entertainment and a spectacular fireworks finale.

### How will your organisation benefit from sponsorship?

Each year, the Show draws an impressive crowd of 4,000 to 5,000 attendees. Many visitors are local; however, the event also attracts a significant number of people from neighbouring districts and across the broader West Australian community.

### What opportunities are available?
