



Toodyay Agricultural Society (Inc)

Formed on 15 November 1853 Toodyay Agricultural Society is the oldest community organisation in Toodyay and the second oldest existing agricultural society in WA.

The object of the Society, a not-for-profit organisation, is to promote agriculture, pastoral pursuits, horticulture, the arts, crafts and social activities within the Shire of Toodyay.

With the support of generous sponsors and a wide range of unpaid helpers, the Society hosts the annual Toodyay Agricultural Show which provides the opportunity to showcase Toodyay to over 4,000 people.

Annual Show Organising Committee

The Show is coordinated by a dedicated team of local volunteers. Committee Members must be 18 years or older and current financial Members of the Society. Being part of the Organising Committee involves:

- Using your own technology, including a computer and phone.
- Procuring a maroon Society t-shirt (and optional jacket) for identification on Show Day.
- Attending monthly Committee meetings.
- Handling the monthly tasks outlined in your Portfolio Overview (where relevant).
- Being available on Show Day, and ideally the day before (set-up) and the day after (clean-up). Note: some roles may require onsite availability during the week leading up to the Show.
- Following the Show Organisation Timeline and keeping the Committee updated with monthly progress reports (where relevant).
- Meeting the Society's financial requirements.
- Helping to advocate for and positively promote the Show and the Society's objectives within the wider community.
