




Sip 'n' See Follow Up Notes

Thanks to everyone who came along this afternoon, it was lovely to meet you. It was so encouraging that all seven guests indicated they are either considering a Committee role, a casual task or continuing as / becoming a Steward... and we're still keen to hear from anyone who couldn't make it.

What the chat covered...

- Our updated written guides (Committee roles, casual tasks and Stewards – available on the Society website or call us, we can get one to you), that include an estimated time commitment to assist potential new volunteers with decision making.
- How roles have been split or created to make them more manageable and accessible.
- Attitude matters more than hands-on skills (they can be learned), but basic computer confidence is essential (email / Word / Excel + moving to SharePoint / OneDrive).
- Volunteering has changed over recent years, broken down into smaller, more manageable tasks with flexible arrangements (including teaming up with others for backup / support).
- All the other ways you can help if sitting on the Committee isn't the right fit.
- A full Committee needs to be in place before planning begins, not just to share the workload, but to give people time and space to build positive working relationships, learn their role, and avoid putting too much pressure on a small number of volunteers.




How the 2025 Committee looked...

- 4 roles weren't filled


How 2026 is currently looking...
